APPEAL AGAINST THE DECISION OF DIVISIONAL MEDICAL BOARD/COMMITTEE for Level-5 (From 7th List of DV up to 8th List of DV), Level-3 (From 5th List of DV up to 6th List of DV), Level-2 (From 4th List of DV up to 5th List of DV) candidates under CEN No. 01-2019

Under CEN 01/2019 for the Level-5, 3 & 2 posts, candidates were sent for Medical Examination to Divisional Railway Hospitals of NCR & NR after their Document Verification conducted by RRB/PRYJ. In Medical Examination, some candidates have been found unfit in the Medical Category required for the post opted by them. These candidates were given a chance to appear before Divisional Medical Board (DMB).

If these candidates want to appeal against the decision of DMB/Three Member Committee they may appeal to the appellate authorities.

- (a) The appeal should be addressed to concerned PCMD i.e., North Central Railway, Prayagraj or Northern Railway, Baroda House, New Delhi and the same is to be submitted to Chairman, Railway Recruitment Board, Opposite NCR Headquarter Office, Near Subedarganj Railway Hospital, Subedarganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh, PIN-211015 for onward transmission to concerned PCMD.
- (b) Appeal should reach at Railway Recruitment Board/Prayagraj office within one month from the date of issue of this notice i.e., **latest by 18:00 hrs on 22.03.2024 by speed post/by person.**

After appeal, no further chance will be given for Medical Examination.

Such an appeal shall be entertained, only if .

1. The appeal should mention the reason/justification for which the candidate making the appeal (**As per proforma B**).
2. The candidate produces a certificate from a Government/Private doctor of the specialty/specialties in which the candidate has been found unfit.
3. Such certificate should contain a note that the Government/Private specialist is fully aware of the physical & visual standards set by the Railways for the particular medical category, and that he is aware of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit according to these standards during medical examination conducted by an

appropriate Medical Board comprising of three Senior Railway Doctors appointed by the Government in this regard (**As per Proforma 'A'**).

4. The certificates should bear the photograph and mark of identification of the candidates duly attested by such a Government/Private Issuing Authority.
5. Such an issuing authority shall also clearly mention its MCI/State registration number.
6. Charges will however be payable by candidate and towards this end a candidate will be required to pay **Rs.1000/- through DD payable** in favour of **PFA, North Central Railway, Prayagraj** for candidates whose medical examination was conducted at **Prayagraj, Jhansi, Kanpur and Agra** and **PFA, Northern Railway, New Delhi** for candidates whose medical examination was conducted at **Lucknow and Moradabad**.
7. The concerned appellate authority and the authority in favour of which D.D. will be drawn is indicated below:

Where PCMD is of the opinion that there should be re-examination of the case of appeal, he may nominate a Medical Board to re-examine the candidate. The recommendations of Medical Board duly approved by PCMD will be communicated to the candidate through RRB/Prayagraj.

In case, the decision changes from Unfit to Fit, the DD submitted will be returned to the candidate. In all other cases, this DD will be credited to Railway Revenue.

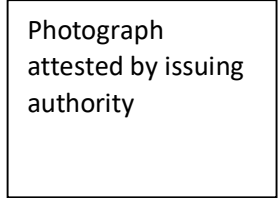
